


<u>A LONG, LONG TIME</u>

This is the question investigated by Infall, a science fiction novel that spans much of the globe while looking at how humans might react to such events. And, in some ways more importantly, how these aliens would react to us.

As you would expect, there is a wide range of reactions. We humans have difficulty seeing "eye-to-eye" over almost everything. It would be no different if aliens started appearing in our world.

The cover was created by a company called 100 Covers, based on my narrative description of what I wanted. I

thought they did a fantastic job of capturing my intent. I believe this is one of the best covers for any of my novels. If you read the book, you will see how well their work fits with the story.

Infall is my eighth novel in the span of eight years. (It amazes me to realize it's been eight years since I wandered down this path. Years are getting shorter and shorter!)

Infall is available in eBook and paperback formats. The eBook price is \$2.99 **but will be on sale from March 2nd through March 9th for \$.99.** (Yep, less than a buck, so you can imagine how rich I'm getting writing novels.)
